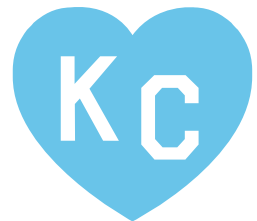
COVID-19 RESPONSE FOR CHILD CARE PROVIDERS

Baby Items

- Baby wipes
- Baby food
- Baby formula
- Thermometers
- Diapers

Personnel Protective Equipment

- Masks
- Exam gloves (non-latex)

Cleaning Supplies

- Cleaning wipes - bleach, alcohol or hydrogen peroxide-based wipes
- Hand sanitizer - with at least 60% alcohol concentration
- Antibacterial soap
- Laundry detergent
- Bleach
