Responses

from large, medium, small businesses, nonprofits, and municipalities 15% employers requiring vaccines for their employees 85% have no such requirement

**34%** employers **incentivizing** vaccines for their employees 66% are not incentivizing vaccines

**78%** employers **requiring mask wearing** in their workplace 22% are not requiring masks

31% employers currently having travel restrictions in place 69% have no travel restrictions



Average level of concern about Delta Variant


20% employers not allowing visitors into their workplace 80% are allowing visitors

**44%** employers have changed their return to office policies due to the Delta variant 56% have not


14% of employers have changed their return to office policies to allow more flexibility for employees with small children 86% have not
