## Get to know a little more about San Antonio before we get there!

#### Haven for Hope

San Antonio's 22-acre, 1600-person full-service campus for the city's unsheltered population, Haven for Hope, addresses the homelessness crisis at a scale that's unheard of, even in California. The facility serves 85% of the city's total homeless population. It virtually guarantees that anybody who wants to sleep indoors can, while accessing a plethora of on-site social services. #### **City Planning for Economic Development**

San Antonio's Economic Development Department last year kickstarted a citywide strategic planning initiative to review the city's role in economic development and update the guidelines used to qualify business investments for economic development incentives and other tax breaks and development grants. The plan has resulted in a new framework for development focusing on 9 key commerce centers in the city and providing special attention to the city's chronically

underinvested neighborhoods. Leadership Exchange delegates will meet with city economic development leaders and learn how the economic development plan and framework are guiding everything from incentives to corridor redevelopment and event construction mitigation grant support for small businesses.
