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COURSE DESCRIPTIONS

Summer of Strategy: Chess Camp (ages 11-14): Learn chess strategies from Kansas City Chess Club coaches. Activities include casual play, lessons, rated competition, building Lego chess sets, and special chess variants. Each student receives a chess set, workbook, and medal. All skill levels welcome!

Veterinary Explorations for Kids (ages 11-14): Hands-on adventure into veterinary medicine! Students learn about animal wellness, injury treatment, and prevention. Covers basics of animal care, common illnesses, and career paths in veterinary science. Perfect for future animal health professionals!

Sitters in Training Babysitting Bootcamp (ages 11-14): Develop skills to become responsible babysitters. Learn essential topics like caring for infants and children, staying safe on the job, handling emergencies, and more! Includes American Red Cross Infant CPR and First Aid certification.

Code Playground: iPhone App Adventures! (ages 11-14): Create your own iPhone apps using Swift! Students tackle coding challenges, collaborate on projects, and design games and interactive applications. Gain skills to continue your coding journey.

Splash of Color: Kids Watercolor Art Camp (ages 11-14): Explore watercolor painting techniques! Young artists will learn blending, layering, and creating landscapes and abstract designs. Perfect for sparking creativity and boosting artistic confidence.

Summer Engineering Camp: Unleash Your Creativity! (ages 11-14): Build submarines, robots, marble runs, and weight-bearing structures in this hands-on outdoor class. Each day explores a different engineering type—from mechanical machines to environmental engineering. Learn problem-solving while using everyday materials.

Braid-tastic Summer: Master the Art of Hair Braiding/Locing (ages 11-14): Master braids, twists, and locs while learning about different hair types. Practice daily on mannequins to build skills. Learn to keep hair healthy and stylish while exploring potential cosmetology careers.

Summer Spotlight: An Adventure into Acting! (ages 11-14): Learn acting basics, monologue performance, and character development through interactive lessons and improv games. Culminates in a Student Showcase where participants perform for family and friends.

Safe Sitter® Training (ages 11-14): This course teaches skills for staying home alone or babysitting. Learn safety skills, child care techniques, first aid, rescue skills, and business basics through games and role-playing.

The Whole World Loves a Clown - Clown/Mime class (ages 11-17): Explore clowning history and skills including juggling, prat falling, and pie throwing. Create your own clown persona, design costumes, receive a makeup kit, and perform in *The Showcase* on Friday night for family and friends.

All the World's a Stage: Basic Acting Techniques (ages 11-17): Build confidence through theater games and exercises. Discover your inner actor and creative potential. Class concludes with a performance for family and friends.

A Magical, Mystical Backstage Tour (ages 11-17): Gain hands-on experience in scenic design, set construction, lighting, sound, and costume/makeup design. Learn technical production organization from concept to completion.

Musical Theatre Workshop (ages 11-17): Give your child the opportunity to shine on stage! Our summer camp introduces young performers to the exciting world of Musical Theatre through fun games, confidence-building exercises, and hands-on performance training.
